Christopher Sonn is a professor at Victoria University, Australia, working with the Moondani Balluk Indigenous Academic Centre, the Institute of Health and Sport, and as cofounder of the Community Identity Displacement Research Network (CIDRN). He also holds a visiting position at the University of the Witwatersrand. His work focuses on the lived experiences of migrant and racialized communities in Australia and South Africa, with particular attention to decoloniality, placemaking, and solidarity through community-engaged research. Christopher has co-authored and edited several key texts in community psychology and is an Associate Editor for both the *American Journal of Community Psychology* and *Community Psychology in Global Perspective*.
