### **Lady Tureiti Moxon**

Lady Tureiti Moxon has a legal background and is the Chair of the National Urban Māori Authority, representing affiliated urban Māori organisations across Aotearoa. She is the Managing Director of Te Kōhao Health, a kaupapa Māori health, education, social, Whānau Ora, justice and corrections service provider based in Kirikiriroa/Hamilton and the Waikato region. Under her leadership, Te Kōhao has grown significantly, expanding its services, and championing Māori kaupapa-based wellbeing solutions.

In 2024 she was awarded an Honorary Doctorate by the University of Waikato, “In recognition of her outstanding contributions to the health and wellbeing of New Zealanders and her commitment to Māori self-determination”.

Lady Tureiti has extensive governance and management experience and is recognised as a Distinguished Fellow of the Institute of Directors. She also has extensive experience in Te Tiriti o Waitangi inquiries. In 2025 she filed a human rights complaint to the United Nations Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination (CERD), addressing discriminatory government policies affecting Māori rights and wellbeing.

Lady Tureiti is a passionate advocate for Te Tiriti o Waitangi, justice and equity, and is committed to solutions designed by Māori for Māori, with everyone. Her work emphasises Mana Māori Motuhake, tino rangatiratanga, and strengthening Māori leadership everywhere locally, regionally, nationally and internationally.
